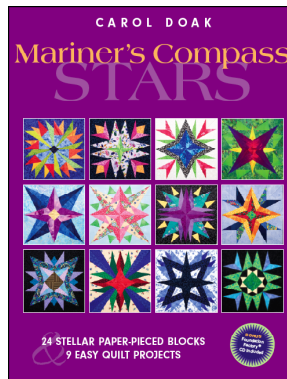


Supply List for Sunrise Quilt Mariner's Compass Stars With Carol Doak

Using paper foundation piecing, see how easily you can make this dramatic Sunrise Wall quilt (25" x 25") featured in my new book, Mariner's Compass Stars. Techniques you will learn assembly-line sewing the sections and accurately joining them can be applied to all the dramatic blocks and quilts in this book.



Supplies:

Sewing machine, size 90/14 needle, open toe presser foot, thread to match fabric, rotary cutter, 6" x 12" rotary ruler, 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler, rotary mat, flat-headed pins, scissors or snips. I will be supplying your foundations.

The reference to color in the fabric-cutting list is for reference purposes only. You may use any color combination. Cut the following pieces and **label each fabric group for the blocks with the location number and section number. Bring extra fabric just in case you make a mistake.**

Yardage Requirements:

Dark green: 2/3 yard for border and binding
 Green/Pink print: 3/8 yard for setting triangles
 Maroon: 1/4 yard for block
 Light green: 1/8 yard for block
 Medium green: 1/8 yard for block
 Peach for: 1/4 yard for block

Dark Pink: 1/4 yard for block
 Light Pink: 1/4 yard for block
 Yellow: 1/8 yard for block
 Gold: 1/8 yard for block
 Backing fabric: 7/8 yard*
 Batting: 30" x 30"*

*You do not need to bring these to class.

Cutting for Setting Pieces, Border and Binding:

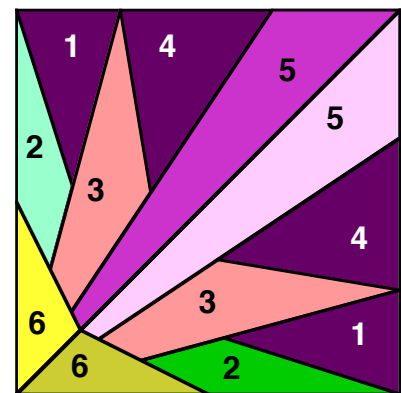
(Cut across the width of the fabric selvage to selvage.)

Fabric	No. to Cut	Size to Cut	Location
Dark green	2	4 1/2" x 25 1/2"	Top and bottom outer borders
	2	4 1/2" x 17 1/2"	Side outer borders
	3	2 1/4" x 40"	Binding
Green/Pink Print	2	9 3/8" x 9 3/8" [/]	Setting triangles

Fabric	Number to Cut	Size to Cut	Location Numbers	Sections
Maroon	8	3" x 3 3/4"	4	A, B
	8	2 1/4" x 3 1/2"	1	A, B
Light green	4	1 1/2" x 5"	2	A
Medium green	4	1 1/2" x 5"	2	B
Peach	8	2" x 5 1/2"	3	A, B
Dark pink	4	2 1/2" x 8"	5	A
Light pink	4	2 1/2" x 8"	5	B
Yellow	4	2" x 4"	6	A
Gold	4	2" x 4"	6	B
