


Carol Doak's Y2K Quilt



Make a quilt with five of these four-block units across and down and you will have a 2,000 piece quilt.

You may reproduce this block design for your own personal use.

Fabric Cutting List for One Block:


For background blacks and navy:

cut 3 squares, each 3" x 3" and cut once diagonally for #'s 11, 12, 15, 16, 18, and 20.

cut 2 squares, each 2-1/2" x 2-1/2" and cut once diagonally for #'s 3, 4, 7, and 8.

For the colored fabrics:

cut 10 strips each 1-1/2" x 5-1/2" for the remaining numbers.



Each quarter block is 6". The four-rotation units are 12".

Five rows of five units of each four-block rotations.

The borders are 9" wide finished

The finished size of the quilt is 78" x 78".
