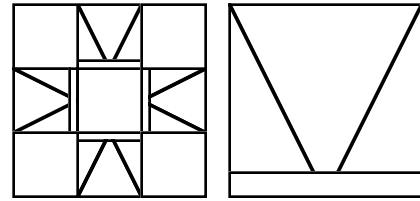

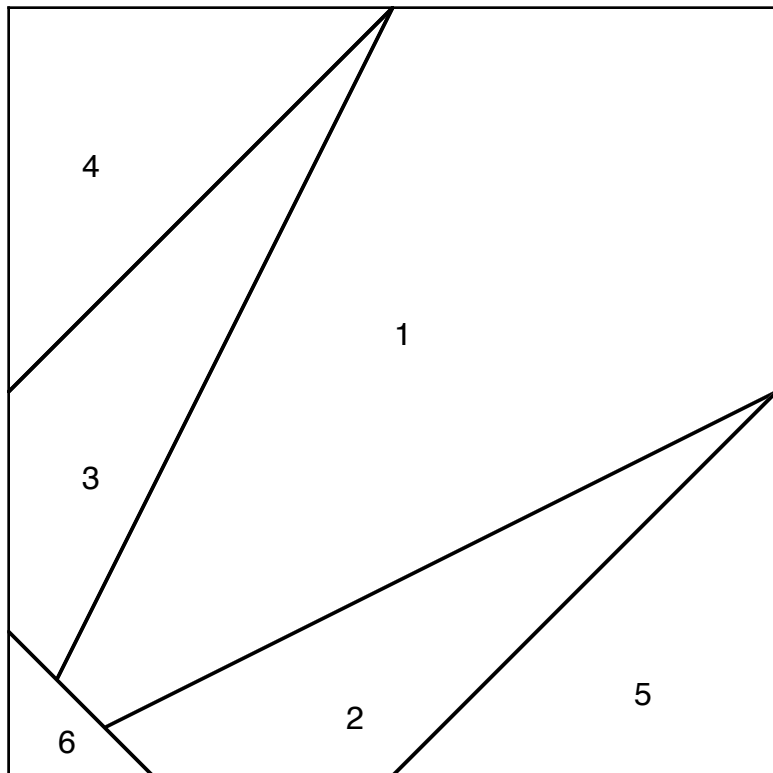
MAKE FOUR

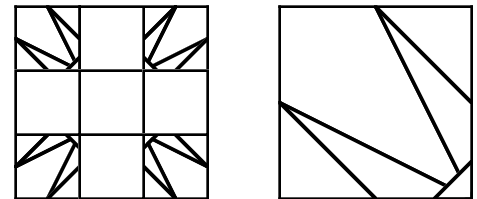

1	4 1/4" x 4 3/4"	4
2, 3	2 1/2" x 5"	8
4	1 1/4" x 4 3/4"	4



Corner Unit

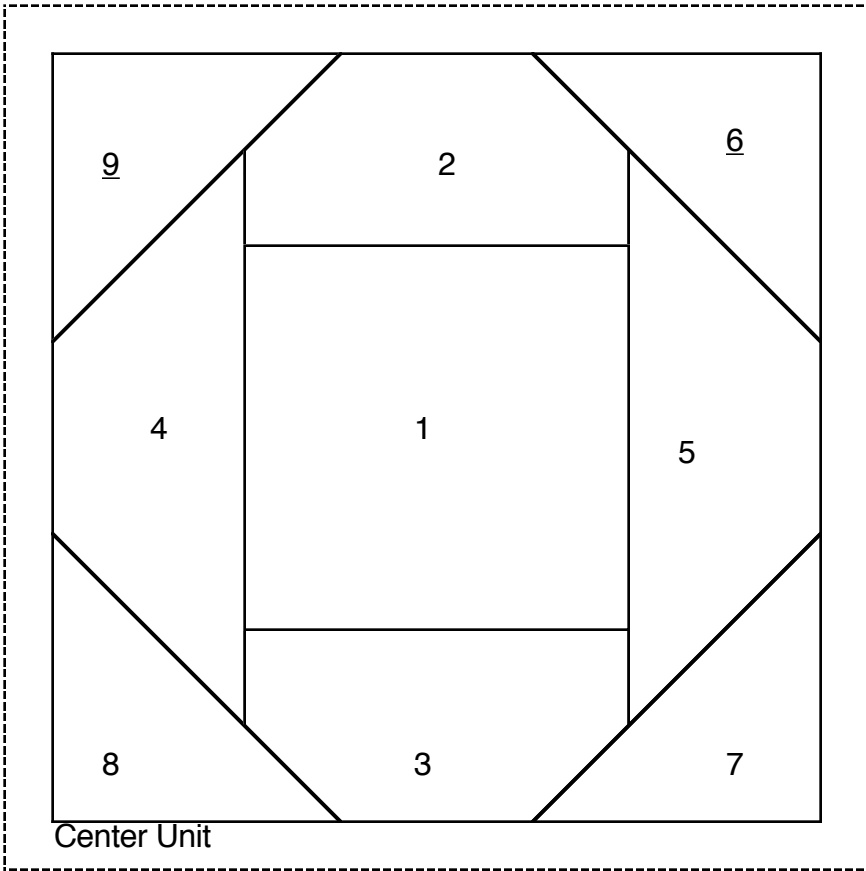

Cutting List for Corner Unit:

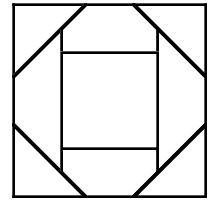
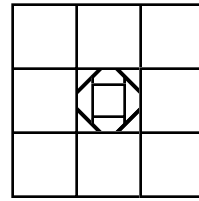
Location	Size to Cut	4 Units
1	3 1/2" x 6"	4
2, 3	1 1/2" x 5"	8
4, 5	3 1/4" x 3 1/4" [/]	4
6	2" x 2" [/]	2

*[/] indicates to cut a square and cut it once diagonally to make triangles.



Center Unit

MAKE ONE



Cutting List for Center Unit:

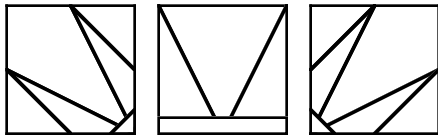
Location	Size to Cut	1 Unit
1	2 3/4" x 2 3/4"	1
2, 3	1 3/4" x 2 3/4"	2
4, 5	1 3/4" x 3 3/4"	2
6, 7, 8, 9	2 3/4" x 2 3/4" [/]	2

*[/] indicates to cut the squares and cut them once diagonally to make triangles.

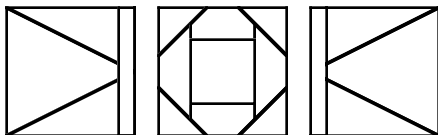
Note: These 9-Patch Star point, center and corner units combine to make a 12" finished size 9-Patch Star block.

This is the same premise as my book, Simply Sensational 9-Patch Star Blocks. The units are quick and easy to make, but produce intricate blocks with those sharp points we love to paper piece.

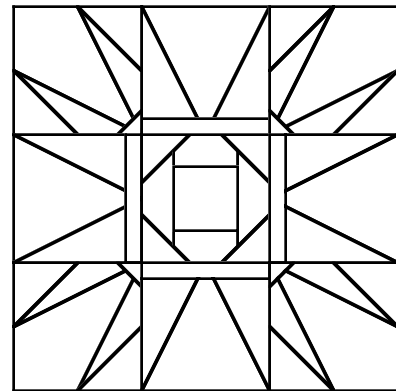
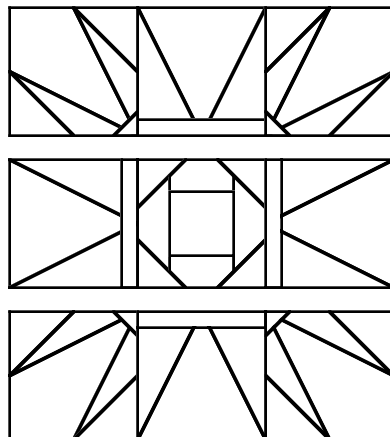
Nine Patch Star



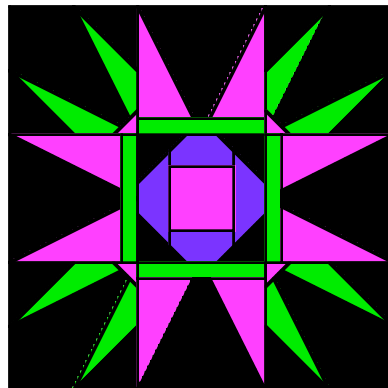
Make two sets



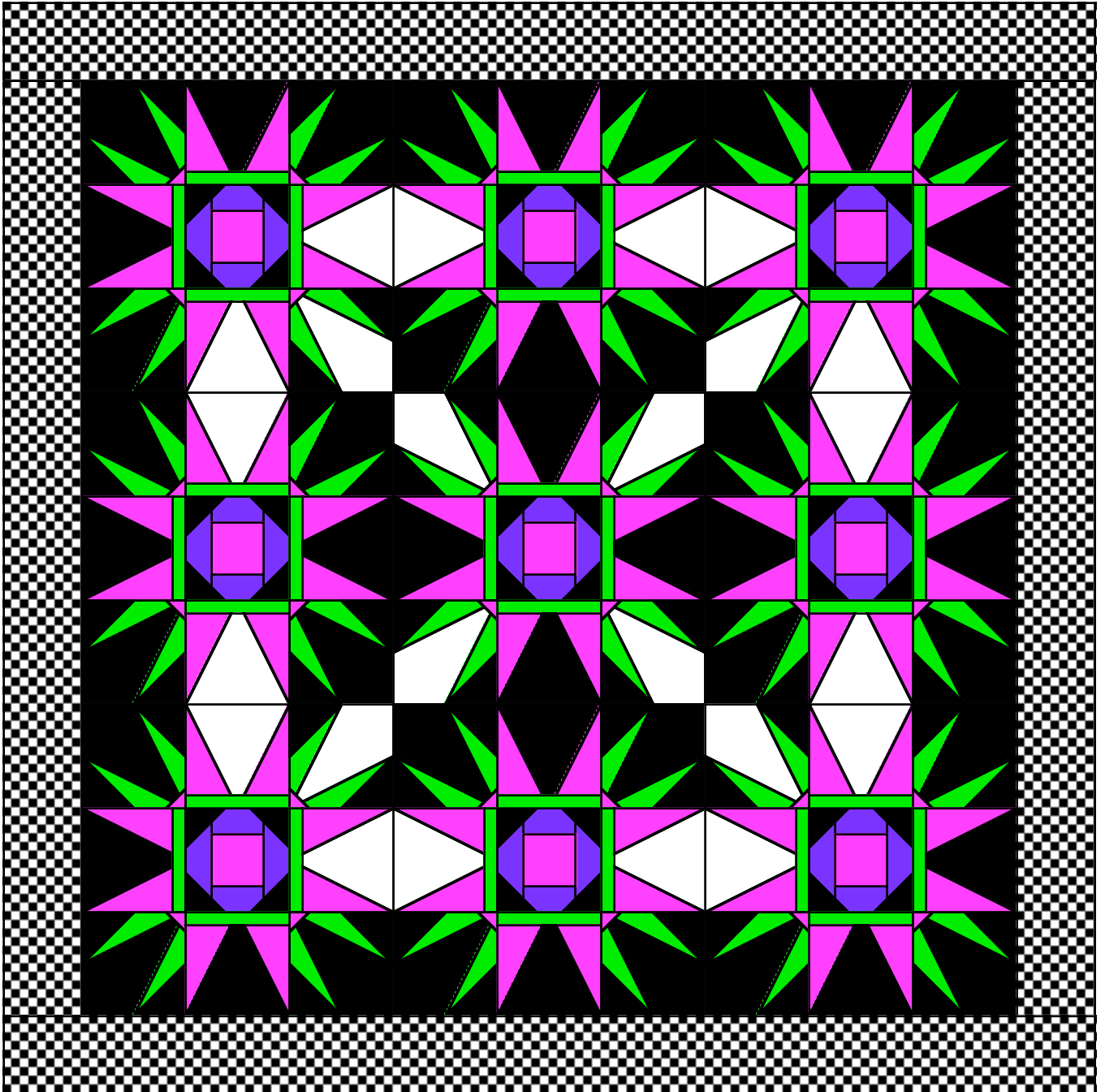
Make one set
