Pre cut the following pieces and label them with their location numbers.

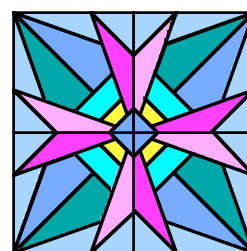
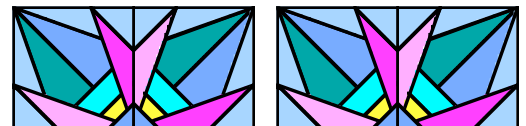
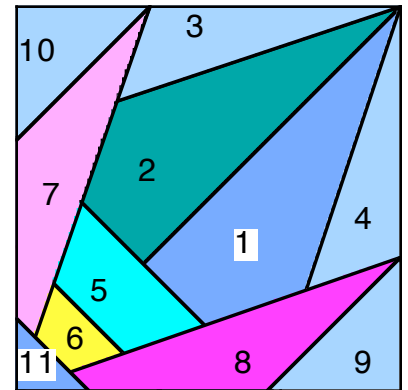
Fabric	No. to Cut	Size to Cut	Location
Lt. Blue	4	3 3/4" x 3 3/4" [/]	9, 10
	8	2 1/4" x 6 1/4"	3, 4
Teal Blue	4	3 1/4" x 7 1/2"	2
Blue	4	3 1/4" x 7 1/2"	1
	2	2 3/4" x 2 3/4" [/]	11
Pink Print	4	2 1/4" x 7 1/4"	7
Dark Print	4	2 1/4" x 7 1/4"	8
Teal Print	4	2" x 4"	5
Yellow	4	1 1/2" x 2 1/2"	6

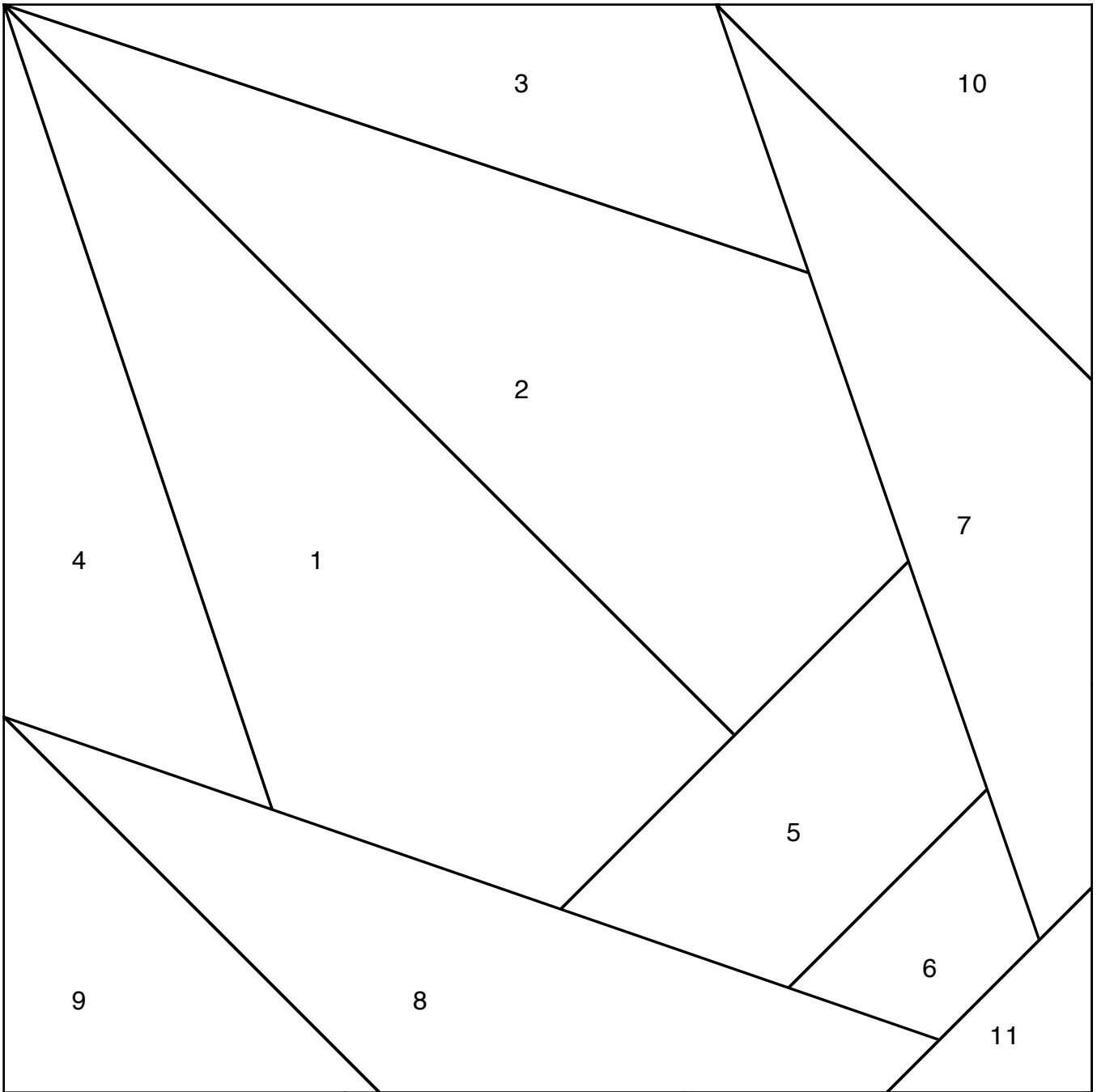
[/] indicates that the squares should be cut in half once diagonally

From the Setting Triangle fabric, cut 2 squares 10 3/4" each and cut in half once diagonally.

From the Border Fabric, cut two strips 5 1/2" x 21" for side borders and two strips 5 1/2" x 31" for top and bottom borders. You will adjust as needed when you are ready to add these.
Binding - 4 strips each 2 1/4" side and joined

1. Trim foundations 1/2" from outside solid line.
2. Paper piece 4 foundations assembly-line fashion.
3. Trim the blocks 1/4" FROM THE OUTSIDE SOLID LINE.
4. Join the foundations to make two 1/2 blocks and then the two halves to make the center block.
5. Join the setting triangles.
6. Measure through the middle, cut side borders this measurement and join them.
7. Measure through the middle including the side borders and cut the top and bottom borders this measurement and join them.
8. Remove the paper and quilt.
